NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY REPORT

The NEP is a policy which is formulated by the government to promote and regulate education even in the rural areas. On 29th Jan, 2021 the Institution Innovation's Cell of AIMA College organized an orientation Session on National Education Policy which was an online webinar from 9.30 am to 10.30am. The guest speaker was Dr. Alexander Pravin Durai M.Com., MBA., M.Phil., Ph.D., Head & Assistant Professor of Commerce, St. Joseph's College Trichy. He emboldened the students to study further and gain more knowledge and also insist "Education throughout Life". His speech about National Education Policy (NEP) along with its features was informative. He also implied the significance of online courses Swayam, Course era, Edex, Internshaala etc., which would be application based rather than theory in the coming future. He focused the importance of Internship and encouraged students to undergo Internships in their respective courses. He narrated that The substantial impetus placed on vocational education or hands-on learning in the new policy will give rise to multiple hybrid jobs. With the rapid progression of information technology, and to be able to offer the students a much broader, multidisciplinary foundation, he expressed the importance of using a holistic and multidisciplinary learning approach which will help the learners adapt and reinvent themselves to the demands of the new hybrid work culture and dynamic socio-cultural changes. He highlighted the National Educational Technology Forum which provides independent evidence-based advice, builds institutional and intellectual capacities, envisions strategic thrust, articulate new directions, and also research. 100 students participated in Google meet and 300 students watched YouTube live stream.


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
