Date: 19.02.2021



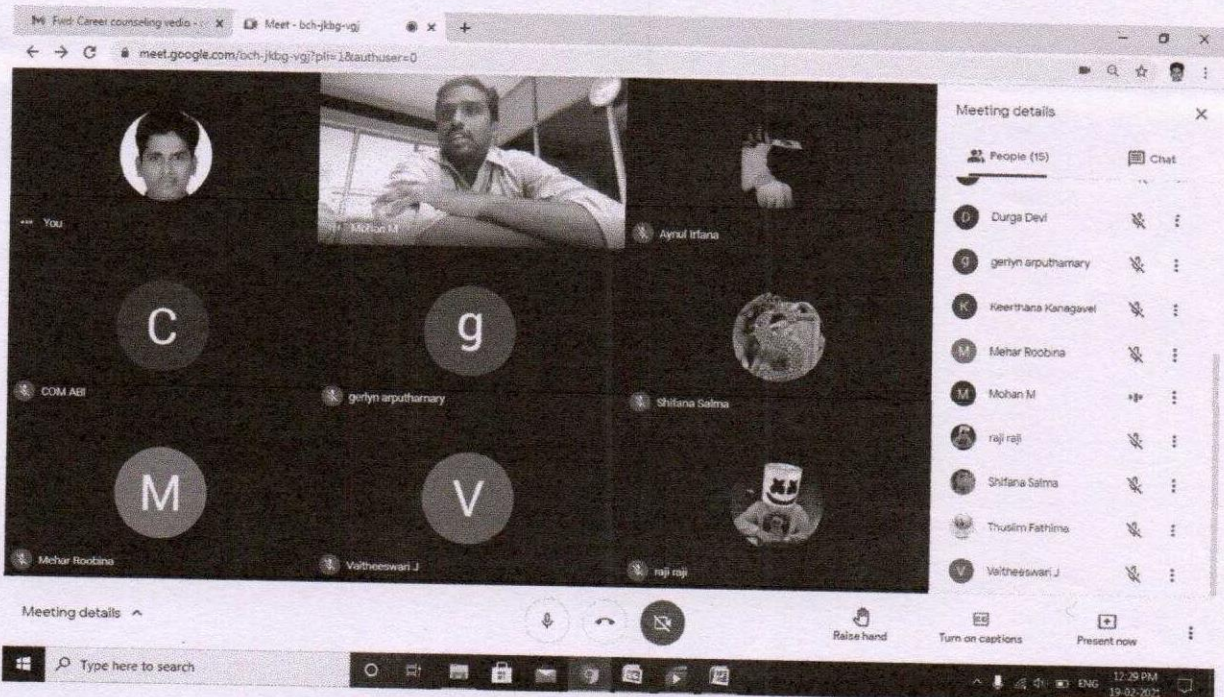
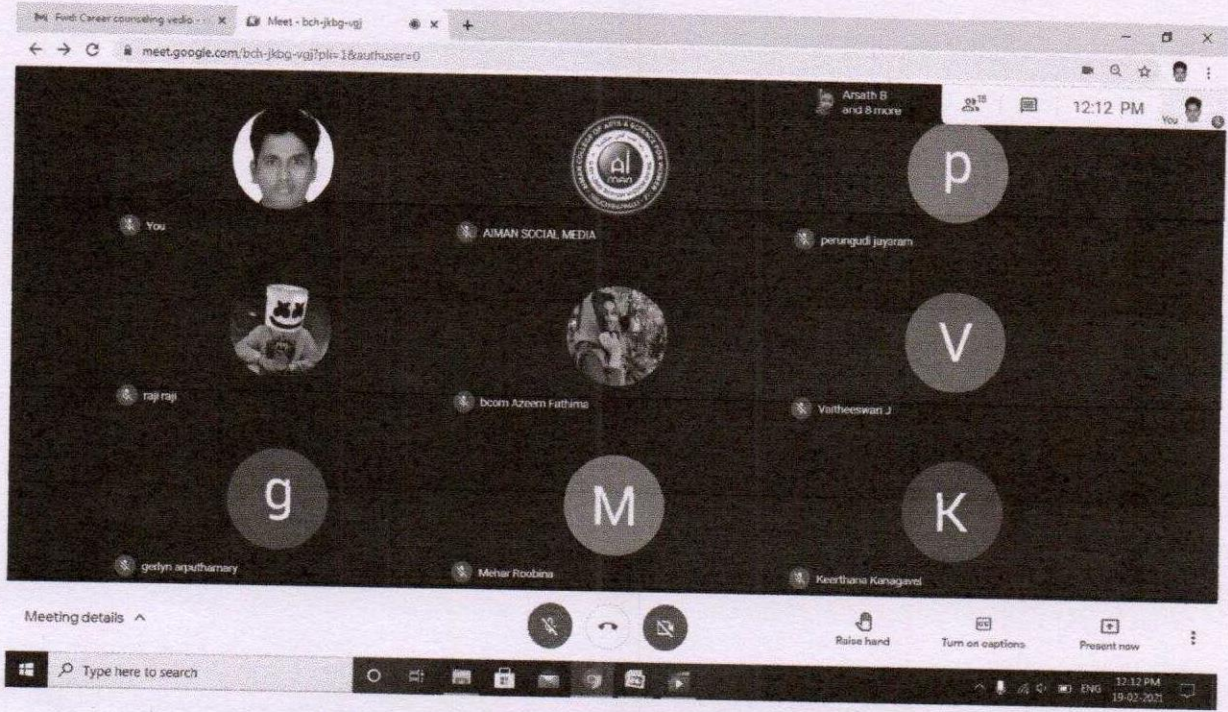
M.Hathija Shifa and A.M.Aynul Irfana III.B.COM, who passed CMA Foundation course in the year 2019, shared their views and experience.

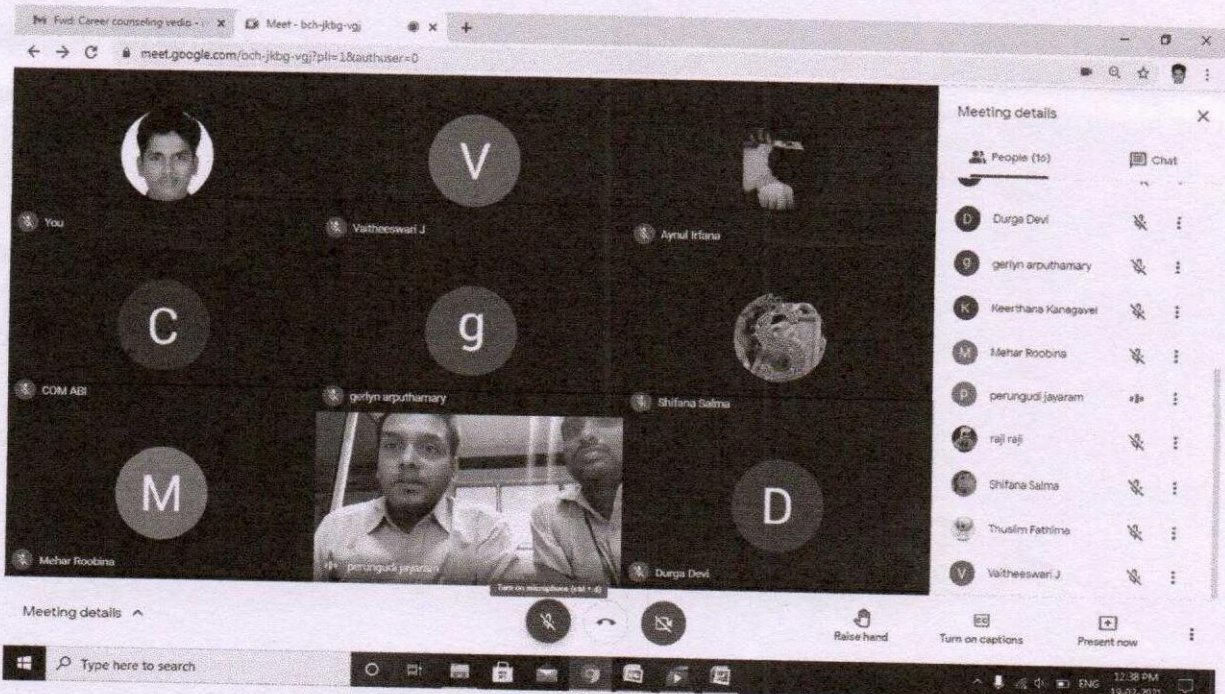
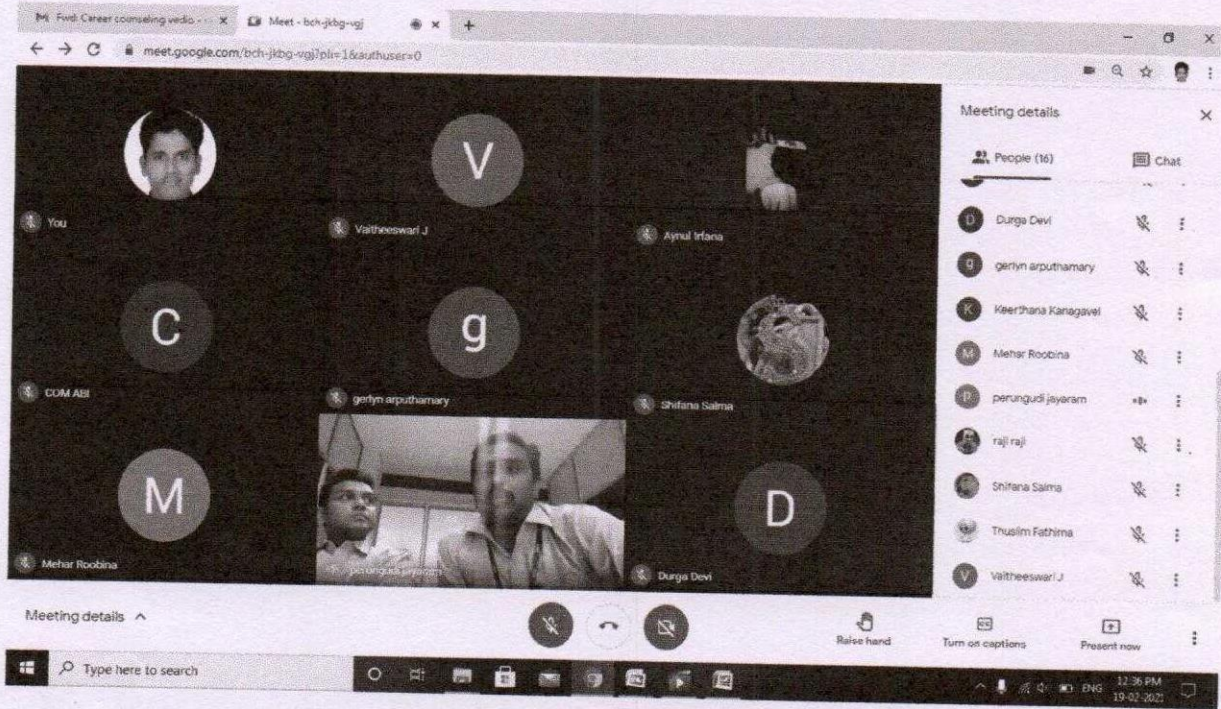
Around 50 students from the Department of the Commerce participated in the programme. A vote of thanks was proposed by M.Farheen Aakila of III B.COM.
