

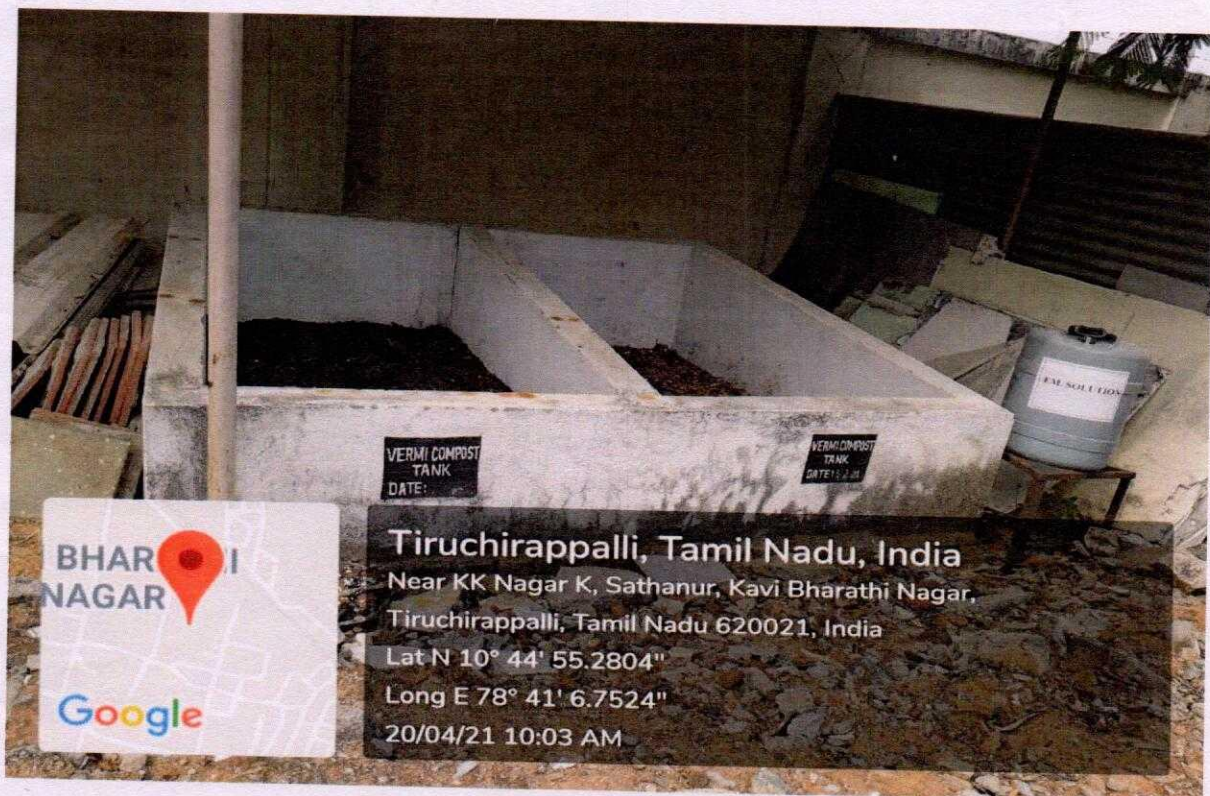
## WASTE MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

### SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

The college has embraced Solid Waste Management measures to convert solid waste into valuable resource. Dust bins are provided in the campus to keep campus clean, neat and tidy. Awareness on segregation of waste is created and blue, green and red dust bins are used. Compost arrangements are also made to convert solid waste into fertilizer/manure. Vermi Compost unit has been established within the college campus. The bio degradable waste materials that are collected in the campus are gathered in the vermin compost unit to convert it into fertilizer used for the purpose of gardening in the campus. The campus is Wi-Fi enabled and hence all communication is made online minimizing the use of paper. Internal and external communications are made through e-mail and WhatsApp to promote paperless office. To minimize the impact of paper use, online submission of assignment is encouraged.

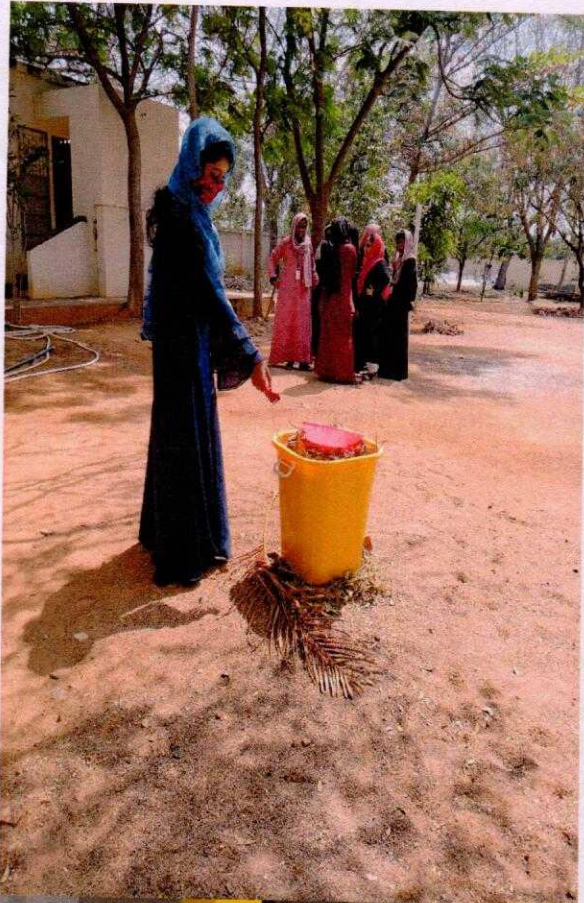

## LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered at Trichy on this day 26th June, 2019 by and between (i) M/S. Tritech Systems, having its registered office at S.F.No.165, Porur/Village Annanur Taluk, Thiruvallur District Chennai-600116 and represented by its proprietor, Mr. A. Mohamed Abdulla, herein after called as Tritech (which shall, wherever the context so admits, include its legal representatives, successors and assigns) on the one part; and (ii) AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women (Affiliated to Bharathidasan University), K. Sahamur, Trichy-620 021 and represented by its Principal Dr. Subashini Friend of the other party/herein after collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a party.

WHEREAS certain scrap materials of E-Waste generated in the campus of AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women are to be disposed of for recycling as per the applicable rules.

Whereas Tritech has approached AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women and offered to purchase such E-Waste scrap materials for recycling and accordingly furnished quotation therefore.

AND WHEREAS Tritech has represented that it has obtained necessary clearance/permission from the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board, Chennai-32 in accordance with the applicable statutory rules and regulations for the above said purpose.

AND WHEREAS AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women has accepted the said offer and both the parties have decided to enter in to an Agreement incorporating necessary terms and conditions governing the said transaction.

NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL COVENANTS AND PREMISES CONTAINED HEREIN, THE PARTIES HERETO ENTER IN TO THIS AGREEMENT AND AGREE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Purchase and Collection of E-Wastes:

1.1 Tritech agrees to purchase from AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women and AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women agrees to sell, 'E-Waste materials' as may accumulate, from time to time, in its campus to Tritech at Porur, Chennai-116 during term of this agreement at the rates specified in the Annexure hereto.

1.2 The rate of prices mentioned in the annexure shall remain fixed throughout the term of this Agreement unless the parties agree in writing for any increased rate of price.

1.3 AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women will inform Tritech of the dates on which the 'E-Waste materials' can be collected from AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women Campus and Tritech will make its own arrangements to collect the said 'E-Waste materials' from AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women campus on the said date or dates.

2. Determination of weight, pricing and making payments:

2.1 Tritech shall arrange, at its expenses, to measure the weight of 'E-Waste materials' on AIMAAN College of Arts and Science for Women campus on a 'certified scale'.

2.2 AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women will take in to account only weight of the 'E-Waste materials' i.e., after deducting the weight of the packing materials or the containers and raise invoice against Tritech at the agreed rates.

2.3 Tritech shall effect payment to AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women on the basis of such invoices issued to Tritech, before transporting the 'E-Waste materials' from Campus of AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women.

### 3. Compliance with applicable rules:

3.1 Tritech assures AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women and undertakes that it shall strictly comply with all statutory rules, regulations or orders that are applicable in relation to collection, storage, segregation and disposal of 'E-Waste materials' for recycling and that Tritech shall be solely responsible therefore.

3.2 Tritech agrees to carry out the instructions/advice given by AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women in regard to method of collection/removal of the 'E-Waste materials' from AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women campus.

3.3 Tritech will, after processing each batch of 'E-Waste materials' collected from AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women campus, generate and provide a 'Green Certificate' to AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women for audit purpose.

### 4. Liability and Indemnification:

4.1 Tritech hereby undertakes that it will handle the entire E-Waste materials collected or removed from AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women campus, in strict accordance with all applicable statutory requirements including the provisions of E-Waste(Management and Handling) rules, 2011, in relation to collection, transportation, storage, treatment and disposal of the said E-Waste materials for recycling. In the event of any violation of any applicable statutory rules, regulations or order, by or on the part of Tritech or its employees or any other person(s) deputed by Tritech in this regard and involved in the said process, Tritech shall be solely liable thereto including meeting all consequences thereof.

4.2 Tritech here by agrees to indemnify AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women from any and all claims, actions or proceedings that may arise, or result in, costs, damages or penalties, with regard to collection, transportation, treatment, storage and disposal of the e -waste materials taken out from AIMAN College of Arts and Science for Women campus by Tritech for recycling.

### 5. Term and Termination:

5.1 This agreement shall be in force for a period of 3 years from the date of its execution unless terminated earlier as provided herein.

5.3 In the event of any such premature termination, each of the party hereto shall be entitled to such privileges and rights as might have accrued to it under the terms and conditions of this agreement up to the date of such termination.

### 6. Entire Agreement:

This Agreement contains the entire understanding and agreement between the parties hereto and that supersedes all prior understanding and agreements whether oral or written, if any.

No modification or amendments to this agreement shall be binding unless agreed by the parties hereto, in writing.
